### Item No. 1 To confirm the minutes of the thirty fifth meeting of the Academic Council held on 16 March 2015.

The minutes of the thirty fifth meeting of the Academic Council held on 16 March 2015, as circulated to the members, were confirmed by the Council.

Before taking up the formal agenda, the Chairperson briefed the Academic Council members on various points for information:

- 1. Restructuring of Deans The Board of Management has approved the creation of Deans which would be role based, viz, Dean (Academic), Dean (Research and Relationships) and Dean (Distance and Short Term Education). The Faculty of Applied Science, and Faculty of Policy & planning now cease to exist
- 2. The University plans to have a focus on strengthening Distance and Short Term Education in the near future.
- 3. A faculty retreat was held on 27-28 May 2015. The Chairman, UGC had spent an evening with the faculty members, interacting with them on various issues.
- 4. The new campuses of the TERI University are at various stages of design. The council would be kept informed as these develop.

# Item No. 2 To consider and approve course outlines of the MSc (Plant Biotechnology) programme.

The following course outlines of the MSc (Plant Biotechnology) programme, as given in the agenda notes, were discussed by the Academic Council:-
