LESSON TITLE: Forests Our Lifeline

TIME [60 minutes]

OVERVIEW

Learners will learn about the trends in urbanization and the causes of urban growth. They will also learn about the demographic, health, environmental and social consequences of urbanization.

SUBJECT/TOPIC **Forests Our Lifeline**

AGE LEVEL Grade VI-VII



(a) Learning Objectives

Learners will be able to:

- 1. explain the main cause of urban growth.
- 2. create a chart that outlines the positive and negative effects of urbanization.

Inquiry

- 1. Why do many people prefer to live in the city?
- 2. List the problems with urbanization.



Materials Needed

- 1. Access to Time lapse Tool
- 3. Computer with projector
- 3. Student Copies of lesson quiz
- 4. Student Internet access

Lesson Summary

- Engage: Learners will be engaged using urbanisation simulation.
- Explore: Gather information about urbanisation in the area they are living in.
- Explain: Identify the impact of urbanisation on air quality, population density of the area.
- Revise: Adjust hypotheses based on additional evidence from class discussion
- Apply: Make an impact by organizing

	educational campaign and an action plan that addresses the threats of urbanisation.

Textbook Chapter : Forests Our Life Line

Engage (5 minutes)

Teacher will introduce the topic by asking the question:

• How are Trees important to people and the ecosystems around them?

Explore (25 minutes)

• Teachers introduce the first source of information using an Timelapse tool.

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• Learners record their observations on the link shown and will infer:

- (i) Why do many people prefer to live in the city?
- (ii) List the problems with urbanization

Explain (20 minutes)

- Learners are divided into small groups.
- Learners share the "hypothesis" with the peers on deforestation and urbanisation.
- Learners will explain the main cause of urban growth.
- Learners will relate deforestation with urban growth.

Revise (10 minutes)

• Learners will create a chart that outlines the positive and negative effects of urbanization
