

# **About the Conference**

The Department of Business and Sustainability, TERI School of Advanced Studies announces its first Doctoral Research Conference in Management which aims to bring together doctoral students affiliated to institutions across India and from international schools for an event of paper presentations, discussions with senior academics and researchers from industry, and publication-oriented development.

The Doctoral Conference invites full research papers from the Doctoral scholars in Management across all areas including Sustainability Management, Marketing, Production & Operations Management, Strategic Management & Entrepreneurship, Finance, and Accounting, Economics, International Business, Organizational Behavior/HRM, Public Policy, Information Management & Analytics, Other Disciplinary and Interdisciplinary subjects.

The submissions are going to be reviewed by a Faculty Review Committee in multiple rounds, from which a group of papers is going to be finally selected for presentation and reviewed by the discussants. We aim to pick a minimum of one paper from each area, for the final presentation. The conference will include plenary sessions with invited keynote speakers.

- The paper should not have been published, or accepted for publication, in any academic journal.

# **Award**



Three Best Paper Awards will be given for the three best papers among those selected for presentation, based on the decision of the Conference Chairs, Discussants and Faculty Review Committee.

\*E-Certificates will be awarded to all authors, presenters, and participants.

Selected papers will be published in the Conference Proceeding book with an ISBN Number.

## **Submission Guidelines**

All the research scholars submitting their research papers should follow the guidelines mentioned below. The participants need to submit the full paper (NOT just the abstract). The only electronic submission shall be accepted at conference@terisas.ac.in

### **Abstract Submission Guidelines**

An extended abstract of not less than 500 words clearly mentioning the purpose, design/methodology/approach, findings, research limitations, practical implications, and value addition and 4-6 keywords. Abstract submission should also include a cover page with the title of the paper, name of the authors, affiliation, mailing address, e-mail addresses, and phone/fax number.

# **Full Paper Submission Guidelines**

- **Cover Page:** The Title page of the paper should contain only the title of the article, author/s' names, affiliation, mailing addresses, phone/ fax numbers, and email addresses.
- **Abstract:** An abstract, not more than 250 words clearly mentioning the purpose, design/methodology/approach, findings, research limitations, practical implications, and value addition, and 4-6 keywords.
- Full Text: A paper should be in the range of 4000-6000 words, including charts, tables, and other Annexure. The text should be justified on both sides and typed in Times New Roman, font size 12. The manuscript must have 1.5 line spacing
- **Figures and Tables:** Figures and tables used in the paper should be in black-and-white. They must be numbered with a brief title.
- **References:** All references should be alphabetically listed at the end of the paper in APA standard reference style.
