DVV requirement

Documents Needed

- Copy of the letter issued by the State govt. or Central Government Indicating the reserved categories (SC, ST OBC, Divyangjan, etc.) to be considered as per the state rule (Translated copy in English to be provided as applicable).
- Final admission list indicating the category as published by the HEI and endorsed by the competent authority.
- Admission extract submitted to the state OBC, SC and ST cell every year.
- Number of seats year marked for the reserved categories.

Specific instruction to HEI

Include only those reserved categories as specified by the State/Central Government orders for admissions. Only those seats filled against the quota should be counted here.

Avoid the following while uploading data

Candidates belonging to the reserved categories who are admitted against General Merit category should be excluded.
