The project objective is to stimulate better understanding of climate responses across the multiple levels of governance in both India and Europe, by mutual learning and comparative approach. The joint support by Indian and European funding agencies (ICSSR, DFG and NW) enables us to conduct conferences and workshops and facilitate the visiting research fellowships for individual researchers at the partner research groups. The central idea behind this collaboration is to bring different expertise of each of the participant research groups to the same platform to facilitate the cross-learning.
