Item No. 1 To confirm the minutes of the twentieth meeting of the Academic Council held on 23 December 2008

The minutes of the twentieth meeting of the Academic Council held on 23 December 2008 were confirmed, as circulated.

Item No. 2 Launch of new MBA programme in Business Sustainability

A draft structure of the proposed MBA programme in Business Sustainability was presented to the Academic Council.

The Council discussed the overall structure of the programme and the core and elective courses proposed in each of the four semesters. It was brought out that this programme needs to be marketed vigourously and projected as an MBA programme with a difference. The aim of the programme should be to produce socially aware mangers and to produce change agents with a different way of thinking.

It was suggested that instead of having a stream of specialisation in information technology, the stream should be focused on technology innovations and technology policies.

It was suggested that the proposed second semester course on Indian economy should be replaced with a course in macro economics.

The Academic Council approved the launch of the programme in the academic year 2009-10 and indicated that individual course outlines be put up to the Council at a subsequent date prior to the commencement of the programme.
