Programme guidelines for Summer School 2025:

1. Programme Leadership for Environment, Awareness and development (LEAD) is open to students of classes 9-12 and will be carried out from June 9,2025 to June 13,2025
2. The medium of instruction is English.
3. Programme LEAD is designed to introduce students to the Environment and Sustainability sector and is structured to cover the following:
 - a. Climate Change
 - b. Data Science
 - c. Design Thinking
 - d. Carbon markets
 - e. Sustainable Development Goals
 - f. AI in business
 - g. Biotech
4. Students are expected to come to TERI School of Advanced Studies, 10, Institutional Area, Vasant Kunj, New Delhi on all days. Travel cost will be borne by the students. It is the responsibility of the parents to pick and drop their ward from TERI SAS campus.
5. The programme duration is from June 9,2025 to June 13,2025.
6. The programme agenda and a roster for the applicant's presence at the TERI School of Advanced Studies will be maintained. It will be the responsibility of the student to be at campus at the prescribed time.
7. Dress code for the summer school is decent casuals. In case you are attending evening activities also, please bring comfortable footwears

9. One self-photograph and [signed consent form](#) from the parent/guardian need to be shared by the applicant at the start of the programme. Students should also carry their school I cards throughout the summer school.
